Individual and Group Volunteer Opportunities:

- Mountain of Food: Package and distribute 20,000lbs+ of food the 3rd Friday of each month from 7-11 a.m.
- Community Garden and Landscaping Maintenance: Help maintain outdoor spaces in the spring and summer. Anytime Monday-Friday during regular business hours.
- Clinic Non-Medical Role: Assist with the Clinic front desk, make appointments, file charts, help with Clinic research projects and data collection. Monday Thursday morning and evening clinics.
- Clinic Medical Role: Nursing intake to include rooming patients, taking vitals, medication review. Pharmacy support. Monday - Thursday morning and evening clinics.
- **Front Desk Reception:** Assist with the building front desk, answering phones, screening and assisting visitors, assisting with special clerical projects.
- **Grab & Go Lunch:** Sponsor a day and provide about 50 fresh meals for carryout during the last two weeks of the month (excluding November and December).
